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Trends

Human trafficking remains a growing and deeply troubling crisis. In Florida, data from 2026 reveals that law enforcement has ramped up efforts, making over 1,600 arrests related to trafficking and exploitation within the past year. These statistics underscore a troubling reality: the problem is not only persisting but evolving.

Quick U.S. Human Trafficking Statistics (2025-2026):

- **Demographics by Gender:** Around 71% of confirmed human trafficking victims in the U.S. are female, and about 14% are male.
- **Age Distribution:** Most U.S. trafficking victims are under 18, with 60% of sex trafficking victims being minors. The average age of sex trafficking victims is around 13 years old.
- **Poverty Link:** Approximately 75% of sex trafficking victims in the U.S. reported living in poverty before their exploitation, highlighting a strong link between economic hardship and vulnerability to trafficking.

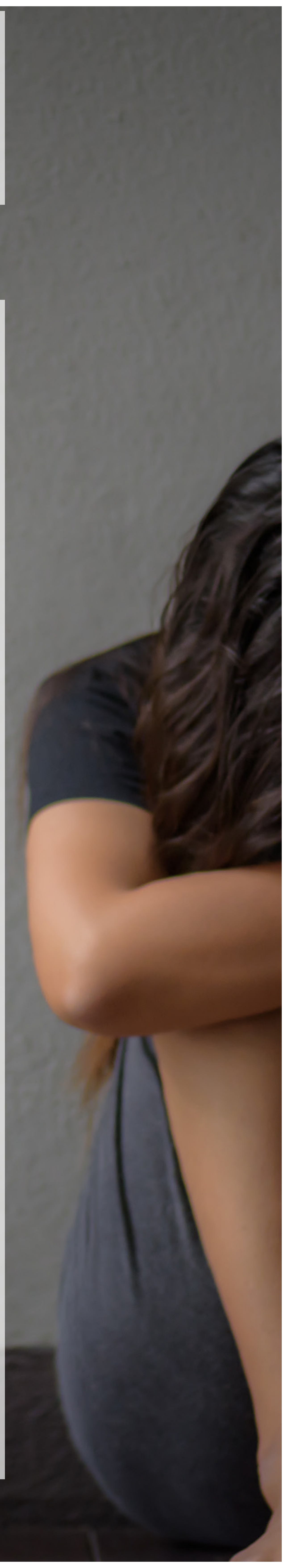

Guided to Safety: Why Advocates Matter

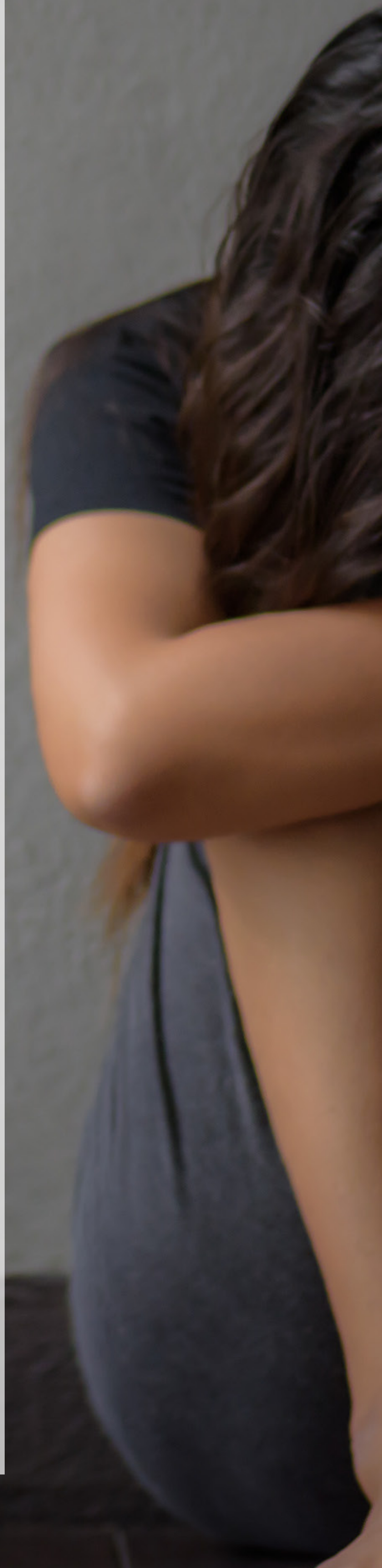

By ensuring they could travel together, Invisible Angels helped preserve that bond and reduce the fear and disorientation that often come with relocation. It was a reminder that dignity, compassion, and family — in every form — matter deeply in a survivor's recovery.



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2027: Where We're Heading: Empowering Survivors Through Education

Invisible Angels is ready to take the next leap — transforming lives not just in the sky, but in the classroom. Starting in 2027, Invisible Angels will launch a groundbreaking educational scholarship program designed to provide the path to true transformation.

We'll begin by offering micro scholarships of \$2,500 to \$5,000 each, allowing survivors to attend vocational and technical schools — from EMT training to veterinary technician programs, cosmetology schools, and other vital trades. As we grow, we'll expand to include community college courses, offering pathways to associate degrees, and eventually, full four year scholarships.

We believe the only way to transforming lives is to empower survivors to reclaim the identity and purpose God has for them. Education is one of the keys to that transformation—a way to provide not just skills, but a new sense of hope and a tangible path forward. If Invisible Angels is still running the same number of flights three years from now, then we are not having an impact on the problem. By investing in education, we'll do more than put a provide a flight out of human trafficking, we will help end it.

The Path Forward: Funding the Future of Change

To make this vision a reality, we'll need to rally our community and raise the resources to fuel this educational mission. We're committed to building a scholarship fund that grows each year, allowing us to start smart, but dream big. With the help of our supporters, we'll expand from micro scholarships to full fledged college opportunities, ensuring that every survivor who wants to reinvent themselves has the tools to do so. This is how we'll create lasting change—one scholarship, one life, and one new beginning at a time.

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
